Updates to the (AUS) Managing CHESSN Data Storage Pages

The CHESSN data storage pages are updated to support changes made by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) for CHESSN Allocation Entitlement information.

On the CHESSN (SCC_CHESSN_AUS) page, in place of the single previous **DEST As At Date** field for entitlement information, a row with its own **As At Date** field is provided for each entitlement type: Ordinary Student Learning Entitlement (SLE), FEE-HELP, Commonwealth Scholarships, and OS-HELP.

In addition, the CLS and OS-HELP (SCC_CLS_AUS) page is redesigned with fields that are updated to record entitlement for each the four groupings of scholarships relevant from 2008: Ordinary Scholarships, Associate Scholarships, Indigenous Enabling Scholarships, and Indigenous Access Scholarships.

CHESSN Data

Student Consent Enter a value regarding the student's consent for releasing their information to HEIMS for CHESSN allocation. Choices are: **Consent Denied**, **Consent Received**, and **Consent not yet sought**.

HEIMS Entitlement Data

Entitlement Request Select this check box if the data is the result of a HEIMS entitlement request.

CHESSN Enter the student's assigned CHESSN. The system verifies the CHESSN number that you enter against the ISO 7064 Algorithm specified by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR).

CHESSN Status HEIMS assigns a status of **Active**, **Provisional**, or **Suspended** to each CHESSN. The CHESSN status is **Provisional** until a student is reported through the LL file as enrolled with their account settled, at which time HEIMS updates the status to **Active**.

Enter the appropriate value in this field.

Comments Enter any comments regarding the record.

Ordinary Student Learning Entitlement, Fee-HELP Entitlement, Commonwealth Scholarships, and OS-HELP Entitlement

For each of the applicable entitlement types, enter the following information:

- Usage** Enter the amount of this entitlement used by the student.
For example, for SLE, enter the of EFTSL (equivalent full time student load) units used by the student. For Fee-HELP, enter the monetary amount of FEE-HELP used by the student. Express the amount in AUS currency or the default currency set for your institution.
- Balance** Enter the amount of this entitlement unused by the student.
- Limit** Enter the maximum amount of this entitlement allowed for the student.
- As At Date** Enter the date when this entitlement data was received from HEIMS.
Data is considered confirmed by HEIMS as accurate on the date when your institution receives it.
