- **Reviewing Alerts Data:** On the Alerts page, the **Sort By** field is deleted, and sorting by name within the grid is changed to sort on last name rather than first name. A new sample Alerts page reflects these changes.
- **Running the SEVIS Alerts Process for F and M Visas:** With this update, the Dependent – Reactivate event triggers only on a status of **Active**. The Events Trigger table in the documentation is updated to reflect this change.

Alerts Header page

The **Sort By** field has been removed from the Alerts Header page because it duplicated the sorting available in the grid. The ability to sort by **Name** in the grid has been changed to sort on the last name rather than first name.

Running the SEVIS Alerts Process for F and M Visas

With this update, the Dependent-Reactive event triggers only when the student has a SEVIS status of **Active**. (Previously, the event triggered on a status of **Active** or **Initial**.)

The Dependent – Reactivate row of the trigger logic table is changed as follows to reflect the update:

Event	Trigger Logic
Dependent – Reactivate	The student has a SEVIS Status of Active . The Relationship Status value in the SEVIS Master component is Terminated . AND The Relationship Status value on the most recent effective-dated I-20 form is Active .
