Consolidate Academic Statistics Process

This section discusses a change to the Consolidate Academic Statistics process for students with a non-active status.

Background

Bundle 2 addressed the issue of the Consolidate Academic Statistics process including students who are term activated in future terms, but whose program status later becomes non-active, for example *Discontinued* or *Dismissed*. In many cases, the effective date of the change to a non-active program status is less than the start date for the term or terms in which the student is term activated.

The solution provided in Bundle 2 was to report students who have programs that are non-active and non-complete, only when the effective date of the status is between the start and end dates of the term being reported.

This current bundle addresses an issue that was introduced by the Bundle 2 solution – that the Consolidate Academic Statistics process does not include students who are on approved leave of absence, even though they are term activated for the reporting term. National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) enrollment reporting requires that students who are on an official leave of absence be reported as part of an institution's enrollment reporting file.

Changes to the Academic Statistics Type Component

The new **Include if Term Activated** check box on the Academic Statistics Type page allows you to select particular program status values for inclusion in a statistics period, if the student is term activated for the reporting term, whether or not the status is active.

For example, you select the **Include if Term Activated** check box for the program status of *Leave of Absence* for a particular **Statistics Period Type**. You then run the process for a statistics period, with the updated **Statistics Period Type**, and a date of 09/15/2007. The reporting term is Fall 2007(8/30/2007 – 12/12/2007). A student has a program status of *Leave of Absence*, with an effective dated row of 07/15/2007 – the student's program is therefore not active at the begin date of the reporting term. However, if the student is term activated for Fall 2007, the Consolidate Academic Statistics process includes this student's record.
