This section discusses the display options for the Operator field on the advisement report.

The following field is new.

AA Oprid Display Option
(academic advisement operator identification display option)

Select from the available options to display or hide the following: operator ID, operator name, or Operator field on the advisement report. The default value is *Display Operator ID*.

Display Name: If you select this option, the system displays the operator's name on the advisement report.

Display Operator ID: If you select this option, the system displays the operator's ID on the advisement report.

Do Not Display: If you select his option, the system does not display the Operator field on the advisement report.

New Information Displayed on the Advisement Report

The following are examples of the new information provided on the advisement report.

Example 1 - a Course with a Course Topic Title, Requirement Designation, and Course Repeat Code

Term	Course	Description	Units	Grade	Code
1997 Fall	PSYCH 100	Intro to Psy	3.00	A	EN
Course Topic: Abnormal Psych					
Requirement Designation: COLB - College Breadth Requirement					
Repeat Code: RERN - Repeat for Earned Units					

Example 1

The system automatically displays the course topic title, requirement designation, and course repeat codes on the advisement report for each class when any of those items exist.

Example 2 - Required Courses and Units

Category II: Complete one life science course and one physical science course; at least one of these courses must have an accompanying lab.	
Requirement Not Satisfied -	
Units (required/actual/needed):	7.00/3.50/3.50
Courses (required/actual/needed):	3.00/1.00/2.00

Example 2

The system automatically displays courses and units that are required, actual, and needed to satisfy the requirement. Previously, the system only displayed the courses and units that were required and needed.

During setup you defined the rules to determine what the system displays on the report for unmet requirements. Previously, the system did not display actual statistical information. Now, if the requirement is satisfied, the system displays the actual GPA, unit, and course.
